DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

AQUATREAT Q-1 is recommended for use in those industrial non-potable waters where a bacterial problem is clearly demonstrated. Examples of **AQUATREAT Q-1** applications include: municipal disposal water systems, water impingement from petrochemical and oil field operations and cooling water recirculating systems. **AQUATREAT Q-1** will control both aerobic and anaerobic type bacteria. **AQUATREAT Q-1** is very effective in controlling the anaerobic "sulfate reducing" bacteria that are responsible for producing hydrogen sulfide. Recommended dosage for slug treatments (the preferred treatment method) may be as high as 500 ppm. Bacterial control may be maintained by use of 30-50 ppm of **AQUATREAT Q-1** on a continuous basis (1 1/2 pint per 1000 gallons equals approximately 30 ppm).
