PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

WARNING

Cause eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

AQUATREAT DNM-25E is a highly effective fungicide and bactericide for use in controlling the growth of bacteria and fungi found in drilling fluids, oil production systems, and hydrocarbon fluids storage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

- (a) Reseal container and offer for reconditioning, or
- (b) Metal Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures.

Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

4. GENERAL

Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

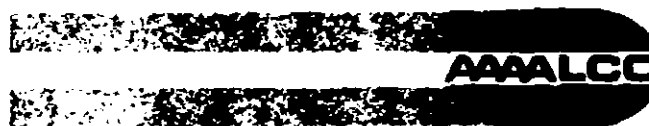

AQUATREAT DNM-25E is used directly from the drum with water. It can be added to the pump.

AQUATREAT DNM-25E is for use in controlling the growth of bacteria found in secondary waterflood systems.

AQUATREAT DNM-25E is for use in controlling the growth of bacteria in shipping containers. It can be used on produced water, fresh water, or the secondary waterflood systems for effective control. It should be diluted with water.

AQUATREAT DNM-25E is used at 1.2 pints per 100 bbl. of water to control the growth of Cereus and Desulfotomaculum species, including Pseudomonas, and other fungi such as Aspergillus at the 1.2 pint per 100 bbl. rate.
