

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

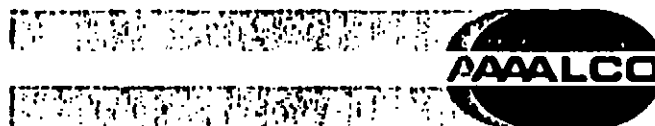
