GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DRILLING FLUIDS

AQUATREAT DNM-30L is a highly effective microbicide for use in controlling the growth of fungi and bacteria found in water based drilling muds. It is especially useful in muds containing starches, xanthanate gums, and wood sugars. The uncontrolled growth of these fungi and bacteria can cause increased corrosion, undesirable odors, and degradation of the drilling mud, especially fluid loss properties.

AQUATREAT DNM-30L is used at the rate of 1 to 5 gallons per 100 bbl. of mud (0.02% to 0.1%). It can be used directly from the shipping container or pre-diluted with water. It can be put in through the mud hopper or added to the pump suction.

SECONDARY AND TERTIARY PETROLEUM RECOVERY

AQUATREAT DNM-30L is a highly effective microbicide for use in controlling the growth of fungi and bacteria found in secondary and tertiary petroleum recovery waterflood systems.

AQUATREAT DNM-30L can be injected directly from the shipping container. It should be thoroughly mixed into the produced water, fresh or salt water or commingled water or the secondary or tertiary oil recovery waterflood systems for effective microorganism control. It may also be diluted with water for injection.

AQUATREAT DNM-30L is used at the rate of 1 pint per 100 bbl. of water for growth inhibition of *Bacillus Cereus* and *Desulfohalobium desulfuricans* and 1 quart per 100 bbl. of water for *Pseudomonas fluorescens*. It is also effective against many fungi such as *Aspergillus*, *Penicillium* and *Trichoderma* at the 1 pint per 100 bbl. of water.

- g. Revise the Pesticide Disposal statement to read as follows:

Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

- h. Revise (b) under Container Disposal to read as follows:

Metal Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures.

Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.
