PRESSURE TREATING WOOD

Use AQUATREAT DCD with a pressure process in one of dual treatments to treat timbers, poles, plywood, and other wooden items to assure protection from attack by decay fungi and mildew. Treated wood may be typically used for decks, buildings, fences, poles, etc.

AQUATREAT DCD is used with a pressure procedure to treat sapwood to achieve retention levels of 0.2 to 0.8 lbs. per cu. ft. of sodium dimethyldithiocarbamate (SDDC).

If desired, compatible fire retardant salts can be added to the treating solution to produce fire retardant wood.
