

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**  
**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**  
**WARNING**

Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and protective clothing (hats, long sleeve shirt, long pants and boots) when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply (or use) in estuarine oil fields where drilling fluids (muds) are discharged in the surface water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**1. PROHIBITIONS**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. **3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**PRESSURE TREATING WOOD**

Use **AQUATREAT DCD** with a pressure process in one of dual treatments to treat timbers, poles, plywood, and other wooden items to assure protection from attack by decay fungi and mildew. Treated wood may be typically used for decks, buildings, fences, poles, etc.

**AQUATREAT DCD** is used with a pressure procedure to treat sapwood to achieve retention levels of 0.2 to 0.8 lbs. per cu. ft. of sodium dimethyldithiocarbamate (SDDC).

**AQUATREAT DCD** should be diluted with water to less than 10% concentration as needed to achieve the correct concentration for sapwood penetration and retention.

If desired, compatible fire retardant salts can be added to the treating solution to produce fire retardant wood.

Maintain a pH of at least 9 during all phases of the treatment. Do not allow the pH in the Cell to drop below 7 because toxic and inflammable decomposition products may develop.

Do not enter Cell after treatment until Cell has been purged with air. Alternately, a face mask with separate air supply may be used.

**AQUATREAT DCD** pressure treatments should be done in conjunction with separate treatments with an EPA-approved, copper-based wood preservative to fix the **AQUATREAT DCD** in the wood.
