DIRECTIONS

1. Assemble waterbed components according to the manufacturer's instructions but do not fill.
2. Carefully open bottle and pour the *entire* contents into the waterbed mattress through the open valve.
3. Fill the mattress per the manufacturer's instructions.
4. Rinse out the empty bottle and discard.
5. No further treatment of Aqua Queen Bacteriacide is necessary for at least one year if the bed remains sealed and no additional water is added. If the bed is opened for repair or to add water, it is recommended that an additional application of Aqua Queen Bacteriacide is made.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
