

The active ingredient, trichloro-s-triazine, is a powerful oxidizing agent which is effective against algae, cyanobacteria, and fungi. It is also effective against gram-negative bacteria and viruses. The effectiveness of this sanitizer is greatly enhanced by the use of a treatment system.

This sanitizer is formulated with a stabilizer. It may be used in swimming pools, hot tubs, and spas. It is formulated for use in both saltwater and freshwater systems. DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER CHEMICALS. See the label for more information. This sanitizer is a potent oxidizer.

**DIRECTIONS**

For general maintenance use, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. Use only 1/4 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water for spot treatment. Repeat treatment as needed. Always use the sanitizer before application.

For algae treatment, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. For cyanobacteria treatment, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. For fungus treatment, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water.

For shock treatment, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. For spot treatment, use 1/4 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water. For maintenance, use 1/2 ounce per 10,000 gallons of water.
