This product is conditionally registered in accordance with section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cure all data required for registration, referred to in 101 of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the following changes to the label on your product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 32259-10."
 - b. Substitute the signal word "CAUTION" for the word "WARNING" on the label. Also, under precautionary statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, delete the statements, "May be fatal if swallowed. May be harmful if absorbed through skin." Note that this is a change in direction outlined in our letter dated July 25, 1985 as recent reviews of toxic data show this pesticide formulation as a Category III toxicant.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

FOR BEST RESULTS

Use on clean, dry, unfinished lumber. Use the total immersion method, where possible, allowing all surfaces complete saturation. Wood to be used below grade or in contact with soil should be immersed 48 hours. All other lumber products one to thirty minutes depending on thickness. For wood unable to be immersed, apply liberally with brush or roller. Give two coats to below grade or soil contact wood. Wood Last may be painted over in 72 hours. Allow

four weeks before applying stain finishes. Product coverage varies greatly with type and porosity of wood, and the method of application.

Clean all tools with mineral spirits or turpentine. Remove WOOD PRESERVATIVE from glass promptly with paint thinner to avoid staining.

WOOD ROT PROTECTION OF INTERIOR WOOD IS ONLY NEEDED WHERE FREQUENT OR Prolonged CONTACT OF WOOD IS A PROBLEM.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Can be used indoors or outdoors.

Preparation before treatment should include machining, cutting, sanding and fastening as required. Wood must be clean, dry, and free from previous finishes. Do not use steel wool before applying WOOD PRESERVATIVE.

Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers, and other heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry, and well seasoned, and immersed in the product for a period of 12-48 hours to be effectively preserved.

THIS PRODUCT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR FEED OR POTABLE WATER STRUCTURES OR LIVESTOCK AND OTHER ANIMAL FACILITIES OR WOOD WHICH WILL BE IN FREQUENT OR PROLONGED CONTACT WITH SKIN.
