

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

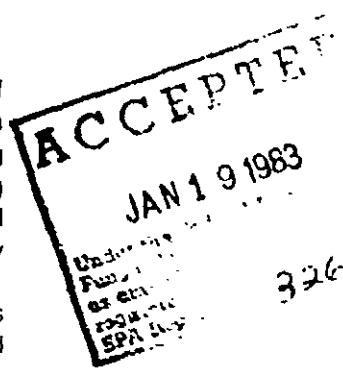
