USE DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas — surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1½ ounces of BIO-PINE per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

USE DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION
