

**USE DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL PURPOSE
DISINFECTION**

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 ounce of MICROBIO-CIDE per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned and then disinfected. All treated food contact surfaces and/or equipment must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 2 ounces of MICROBIO-CIDE per gallon of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a cleaning solution before disinfection.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 ounce of MICROBIO-CIDE per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned and then disinfected. All treated food contact surfaces and/or equipment must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive to eyes, skin and clothing. Do not get in eyes, on face, or on clothing. If contact occurs, flush with water for 15 minutes. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention if necessary.

FIRST AID

In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If contact with skin occurs, wash with soap and water. If contact with clothing occurs, remove clothing immediately. If inhaled, move to fresh air. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention if necessary.
