All Season Diazinon 5G Insecticide EPA Registration Number 32802-5 Your submission dated June 28, 2001

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. In the Environmental Hazards, shorten the sentence beginning "Do not apply direct to water, or to areas..." to just "Do not apply directly to water.".
 - b. The heading SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS TO REDUCE RISKS TO BIRDS and its associated text should appear within an outline box.
 - c. In the first sentence of the third paragraph under the heading Area Lawn Treatment, revise "squar feet" to "square feet".
 - d. Under the heading Lawn Spot Treatment, replace "(do not use high garden hose that may disturb ants and cause migration, reducing the effectiveness. of treatment)." with "Do not use high pressure watering from a garden hose that may disturb ants and cause migration, reducing the effectiveness of treatment.".

- e. Under the heading Home Vegetable Gardens, revise the sentence "Do not apply this product to food crops grown in greenhouses." to read "Do not apply this product in greenhouses.".
- 3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
- 4. Comply with all applicable provisions of the 2000 Memorandum of Agreement Regarding Pesticide Products Containing Diazinon (i.e., the Diazinon MOA). In accordance with the Diazinon MOA you have requested the following revisions to the conditions of registration for this diazinon product with outdoor non-agricultural (i.e., home and garden) uses:
 - a. You have requested under section 6(f) of FIFRA that this registration be voluntarily canceled on a date not later than December 31, 2004.
 - b. You may not manufacture, label, or release for shipment this product after June 30, 2003.
 - c. You may not sell or distribute this product after August 31, 2003.
 - d. The registration for this product shall expire and be canceled on December 31, 2004.

e. You will send to every person who directly purchases this product (i.e., to every seller) a notification of Product Recovery Program to be conducted by Syngenta and Makhteshim after December 31, 2004.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 27, 2001 which identifies a replacement diazinon source Manufacturing Use Product is acceptable and has been added to this product's registration file.

This product contains diazinon, an organophosphate that inhibits cholinesterase. If symptons of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal, but should be administered only in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is highly toxic to birds. fish and other wildlife. Do no apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas belowthe mean high water mark. Runoff may be hazardous to fish and other aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where aquatic life are important resources. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal or equipment wash waters.

- 1. Do not treat areas larger than 15,000 square feet.
- 2. If repeat application is necessary, wait at least 3 weeks between applications. Make no more than 4 applications per year.

LAWN APPLICATIONS:

ON LAWNS THIS PRODUCT KILLS:

Armyworms, Ants, Bermudagrass Mites, Billbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Clover Mites, Crickets, Cutworms, Digger Wasps, Earwigs, Fire Ants (aids in control), Fleas, Leafhoppers, Millipedes, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), Sowbugs, Springtails (Collembola), Hyperodes Weevils, and White Grubs (larvae of European Chafer, Southern Chafer, Japanese Beetle, Dung Beetle).

AREA LAWN TREATMENT:

To control Armyworms, Ants, Bermudagrass Mites, Billbugs, Brown Dog , Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Clover Mites, Crickets, Cutworms, Digger Wasps, Earwigs, Fire Ants (aids in control), Fleas, Leafhoppers, Millipedes, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), Sowbugs, Springtails (Collembola) on grass and dichondra lawns: Apply 2 pounds per 1000 square feet (87 pounds per acre). Apply when lawn is dry, then water lawn lightly after application.

To control Billbugs and White Grubs (larvae of European Chafer, Japanese Beetle and Southern Chafer, Dung Beetle): Apply 2 pounds per 1000 square feet. (87 pounds per acre). Water lawn with at least 1/4" of water after application (but stop before puddling occurs). For White Grubs, apply between late July and early October. For dung beetle grubs, apply in spring or summer when damage is first noticed. For Billbugs, apply when activity is first observed or when chewed grass shows Billbug damage. Repeat as necessary.

To control Hyperodes Weevil: Apply 2 lbs. per 1000 squar feet (87 pounds per acre). Water lawn with at least 1/4" of water after application (but stop before puddling occurs). Treat problem areas in April and again in mid-May.

LÁWN SPOT TREATMENT:

Ants: Apply 1 1/2 teaspoon of granules over and around each ant hill. Digger Wasps: Apply 1 1/2 teaspoons of granules in and around each nest opening. Apply at dusk when wasps are not active.

Fire Ants: To aid in the control of Fire Ants in lawns and other outdoor home recreation areas, apply 1/2 cup of granules over and 2 feet around each ant mound. Immediately after application, water the granules in with at least 1 gallon of water for each mound. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. (do not use high garden hose that may disturb ants and cause migration, reducing the effectiveness, of treatment). For best results, apply in cool weather (65°F to 80°F) or in early morning or or late evening hours. Reapply as necessary. Treat new mounds as they appear. Works within 24 hours. No waiting for days or weeks.

BAND TREATMENT AROUND HOUSE FOUNDATION:

The following insects are commonly found around or near house foundations and may enter the house: Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Springtails (Collembola). To help prevent insects from invading the home, apply a 2 foot wide band of this product next to the house foundation. Distribute the insecticide granules uniformly, at the rate of 3.2 ounces (XX tablespoons, as determined by product density) per 100 square feet (2 ft x 50 ft) (2 pounds per 1000 square feet). If necessary, repeat application at 3 week intervals.

HOME VEGETABLE GARDENS: SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS TO REDUCE RISKS TO BIRDS:

- Thoroughly mix insecticide granules into soil during or immediately after application...
- Granules, that are spilled or are visible on soil surfaces should be covered with soil thoroughly mixed into the soil.

IN HOME VEGETABLE GARDENS THIS PRODUCT KILLS:

Cutworms, Mole Crickets, Onion Maggots, Root Maggots, Wireworms.

HOME VEGETABLE GARDENS: This product kills certain garden insects on crops as listed. Apply granules uniformly at the listed rate; use higher rate only for heavy infestation of insects. Do not apply this product to food crops grown in greenhouses.
