General Classification

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Crabgrass Preventer Plus to the turf prior to the germination of weed grasses since Crabgrass Preventer Plus will not control established weeds. Apply when grass is dry and water thoroughly after application.

- * Apply in spring before temperatures reach 70-75° for 3 consecutive days.
- * Do not reseed for at least 6 weeks after application.
- * Do not apply the spring following a fall seeding.
- * Do not apply to bentgrass putting greens.
- * Apply accurately and uniformly
- * Regular fertilizing with Crabgrass Preventer thickens turf, crowds out weeds.
- * Renew thin turf by interseeding with lawn seed after the 9 week precautionary period has ended.

Suggested Spreader Settings

NOTE: Spreader calibrations may change with wear of spreader. Check settings and calibrations on small area of lawn before total application. To reduce the possibility of streaks, you may wish to set positive feed spreaders at 1/2 recommended settings and apply both lengthwise and across.
