The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully **REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE** of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted only those changes to your labeling which are necessary to comply with PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11, which reflect the WPS labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K. 

Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and the grass is dry. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product is toxic to fish, birds, and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Use only as directed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in its original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. SURFACE FEEDING INSECTS

For control of Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), Ants, Armyworms, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, and Sowbugs, apply this 50 pound bag to uniformly cover 15,150 sq. ft. of turf. Refer to Spreader Settings. This application supplies the turf with 0.53 lbs. Nitrogen per 1,000 Sq. Ft. while controlling insects as listed. Treat in the spring or when insects first appear troublesome and repeat as needed for control. Immediately after application lightly sprinkle the area to move the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Do not allow children or pets on the area until the grass is dry.

ROOT FEEDING INSECTS

For control of Billbug Larvae and the "White Grub" larvae of Japanese Beetle, European Chaffer, Southern Chaffer and Hyperodes Weevil, apply this 50 lb. bag to treat 7575 Sq. Ft. of lawn. This supplies the turf with 1.05 lbs. Nitrogen per 1,000 Sq. Ft. while giving control of the above mentioned soil insects. Apply the granules uniformly over the area and immediately follow with a thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the soil. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface which is usually in late July and early August. For Hyperodes (Turfgrass) Weevils apply in Mid-April and again in Mid-May at the same rate. Consult your Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat in your area. Keep children and pets off treated area until grass is dry.
