CAUTION:

When watering-in of the insecticide is directed keep public (especially children and pets) off treated areas until the insecticide has been watered into the soil and the grass is dry. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing

person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and warm water. Wash clothing before reuse.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection only is an antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish, and aquatic invertebrates. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Clean up spilled product to reduce exposure to wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on golf course turf. Maximum application rate is 1 lb active ingredient per acre.

SURFACE FEEDING INSECTS: For control of Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), Ants, Armyworms, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, and Sowbugs, apply 3.3 pounds uniformly to cover 1000 square feet of turf. Refer to Spreader Settings. Treat in the spring or when insects first appear troublesome and repeat as needed for control. watering-in of the insecticide is not required for control of surface insects.

FOR ROOT FEEDING INSECTS: For control of Billbug Larvae and the "White Grub" larvae of Japanese Beetle, European Chafer, Southern Chafer and Hyperodes Weevil, apply 3.3 pounds of product per 1000 square feet of turf. Apply granules uniformly over the area and follow with a thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the soil. For best results apply when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface which is usually in late July and early August. For Hyperodes (Turfgrass) Weevil apply in mid-April and again in mid-May at the same rate. When watering-in of the insecticide is directed keep public (especially children and pets) off treated areas until grass is dry. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Consult your Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat in your area.

EUROPEAN CRANE FLY LARVAE (Leather Jacket): For specific control of the Crane Fly larvae feeding in western states turfgrass, apply 3.3 pounds per 1000 square feet. The larvae will also be controlled simultaneously when an application rate for Grubs (3.3 pounds per 1000 square feet) has been made. Keep public (especially children and pets) off treated area until granules have been washed into soil and the grass is dry. Consult your Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat in your area.
