SURFACE FEEDING INSECTS: For control of CHINCH BUGS, SOD WEBWORMS (Lawn Moth), ANTS, FLEAS, ARMYWORMS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, and SOWBUGS apply at the rate of 1 pound / 1,000 Sq.Ft. of turf. (50 lb. bag treats 50,000 Sq.Ft.). Refer to chart for respective spreader settings. Make sure your Spreader is calibrated for this product before application.

Treat in the spring (mid-May to June) or when your "Lawn Program" calls for a Surface Insect control applications. Repeat as the program indicates or as needed for control. Sod Webworms may have 3 to 4 generations of larvae in 1 year which may require additional treatments at 30 to 60 day intervals during the summer months. Lightly sprinkle the area after treatment as soon as possible to move the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation. Advise or "post" the treated area not to allow children or pets on treated areas until the insecticide has been sprinkled and the grass is dry.

USE AS A BAND TREATMENT AROUND THE HOME

To protect the dwelling from possible insect infestations a band of granules may be placed around the building to control Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs, Springtails and Spiders. One pound of this product will treat a 5 foot wide band 100 feet long, around the home, (4 ounces will treat a band 20 feet long). Acts as a barrier against insects invading the home. Apply when the insects have become troublesome or before they cause problems in the spring or early fall. Repeat as needed for control.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont.)
 WHITE GRUB LARVAE CONTROL IN THE TURF

FOR ROOT FEEDING INSECTS such as BILLBUG LARVAE, and the "White Grub" larvae of JAPANESE BEETLE, EUROPEAN CHAFER, SOUTHERN CHAFER AND HYPERODES WEEVIL apply 2 lbs./ 1,000 Sq.Ft. of turf (50 lb. bag treats 25,000 Sq.Ft.). Make sure your spreader is properly calibrated to apply this product. Irrigate the turf after treatment as soon as possible to wash the insecticide into the root zone where the insects are feeding. Apply when the White Grub Larvae are young and actively feeding near the soil surface in mid July and early August. For the HYPERODES (Turfgrass) WEEVIL larvae apply in Mid-April and again in Mid-May at the same rate as above.

After application advise or "post" the treated area not to allow children or pets on treated areas until insecticide has been washed into the soil and the grass is dry. Consult your Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat for "Grubs" in your area.

HOW TO APPLY

The following spreader settings are for use with new equipment. Your used spreader may need calibrating. Since proper application is based on the spreaders condition with regard to age and use, your walking speed and the evenness of the terrain, your spreading equipment may require adjustments.

If you have reason to believe that your spreader is not calibrated correctly test apply by placing the amount for 500 Sq.Ft. into your spreader and apply to your pre-measured 500 Sq.Ft.(5 ft. wide by 100 ft long) or by other suitable calibrating methods.
