

Treat in the spring (mid-May to June) or when your "Lawn Program" calls for a Surface Insect control applications, kepeat as the program indicates or as needed for control. Sod Webworms may have 3 to 4 generations of larvae in 1 year which will require additional treatements at 30 to 40 day intervals during the summer months. Lightly sprinkle the area after treatment as soon as possible to move the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation. Advise or "post" the treated area not to allow children or pets on treated areas until the insecticide has been sprinkled and the grass is dry.

USE AS A BAND TREATMENT AROUND THE HOME

To protect the dwelling from possible insect infestations a band of granules may be placed around the building to control Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Nillipedes, Soubugs, Sringtails and Spiders. For specific control of the Grane FLy Larvae feeding in western states turfgrass apply 25 lbs, to cover 18,750 sq.ft. The larvae will also be controlled simultaneously when an application rate for Grubs (25 lbs/12,500 Sq.ft.) has been made. Consult your Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat in your area. Keep children and pets off treated area until granules have been washed into soil and the grass is dry.

The following spreader settings are for use with new equipment. Your used spreader may need calibrating. Since proper application is based on the spreaders condition with regard to age and use, your walking speed and the eveness of the terrain, your spreading equipment may require adjustments. If you have reason to believe that your spreader is not calibrated correctly test apply by placing the amount for 500 Sq.Ft. into your spreader and apply to your pre-measured 500 Sq.Ft.(5 ft. wide by 100 ft long) or by other suitable calibrating methods.



As an aid in the control and reduction of Imported Fire Ants by individual Ant mound treatment apply 4 level tablespoonfuls (2/3 ounce) of granules evenly in a circle around the outer edges (1 to 2 feet from center) of mounds measuring from 3 to 12 inches in diameter. Finish the treatment then by applying 2 level tablespoonfuls (1/3 ounce) sprinkled evenly over the center of the mound. Best results will be obtained if mound is not disturbed after treatment thus allowing ants to come and go and to be exposed to the insecticide treated area. Apply the granules when Ants have become a nuisance and repeat as needed but not more than once every 7 days.
