HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation of dust and contact with eyes, skin or clothing. When using this product, wear long pants, long-sleeved shirt, socks and shoes. After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until dust has settled.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE Store in original container and keep any bags containing unused product in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and domestic animals. Do not store near feed or feedstuffs. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near other fertilizers or near herbicides, insecticides, fungicides or seeds.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: To dispose of bags which contain unused product, securely wrap bag in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty bag. Fold empty bag and discard in trash.

ALL SEASON TRIAMINE® WEED AND FEED will control the most prevalent broadleaf weeds occurring in home lawns while providing a blend of nutrients that will make your lawn lush and green. This product may be used on bluegrass, fescue, ryegrass, Bermuda, St. Augustine, centipede grass Bahia and zoysia lawns. Do not use on dichondra and Carpetgrass or Bentgrass lawns. Keep away from inside the drip line of shrubs and ornamentals and do not apply to allow to drift onto vegetables or flower gardens.

WHEN TO APPLY

1. Best results are obtained when weeds are growing rapidly.
2. Apply when grass is moist, after a rain, irrigation, heavy dew, or other watering methods.
3. Avoid mowing or watering the lawn for 48 hours after application. This gives the broadleaf killer time to be absorbed into the weed leaves.
4. Do not reseed lawns for 4 weeks after application. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns until after 3 mowings.
5. In cases of severe weed infestations, hard to kill weeds such as chickweed, or less than optimal weed killing conditions, (e.g. weeds are not actively growing, cool weather occurs, or product was washed off the weed), it may be necessary to retreat the lawn three to four weeks after the initial application of Weed & Feed. This application could take the place of the normal summer TURF FOOD application.
6. The maximum rate to turf is 0.46 pounds of 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.
7. When used during hot (over 85 degrees F) and/or dry conditions apply WEED & FEED at one-half the recommended rate to lessen the chance of burning your lawn.
8. Under conditions of adequate moisture, high temperature, and high humidity, temporary discoloration may occur if over-application occurs on St. Augustine-grass.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply ALL SEASON TRIAMINE® WEED & FEED with a lawn spreader either as one pass or by applying at half-rate in two passes. If spread using the two-pass method, run the second pass at right angles to the first. The following rates are approximate. Check your spreader manual for additional instructions. The condition of your spreader will greatly affect its rate of application. Walk at a normal pace while applying. Check your spreader on a 250 sq.ft. section and adjust your setting to apply one pound of WEED & FEED to this area. Wash out your spreader after each use and allow it to dry thoroughly. Treat any exposed metal areas with oil to prevent corrosion.
