### READ WARNINGS AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is a scientifically prepared plant food especially formulated for rose and shrub feeding, with a highly effective systemic insecticide. When used as directed, it kills insects as listed on roses, shrubs and flowering plants as listed.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS AND FLOWERS: This product may be used on the following plants: Azaleas, Abelia, Birch, camellias, Crataegus (non-edible varieties), Flowering Quince, Gardenia, Geranium, Gladiolus, Honeysuckle, Hydrangea, Ilex, Iris, Lantana, Lilac, Lily, Magnolia, Peony, Roses, Spirea, Viburnums, Wigella, and other common flowering shrubs such as Rhododendron, and green plants such as Aralia, Ficus, Dracena, Philodendron and Shefflera.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: This product will control Aphids, Birch Leaf Miners, Camellia Scale, Elm Leaf Beetle, European Elm Scale, Holly Leaf Miner, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Mimosa Webworm, Spider Mites, Pine Tip Moth, Soft Scale, Thrips and Whiteflies,

HOW OFTEN TO USE: Since this product will control insects from 4 to 6 weeks and gives the plant a balanced feeding, it should be applied to omamental plants every 5 to 6 weeks to provide a continuous supply of insecticide and plant food. For newly set plants, apply at planting time and 5 to 6 week intervals. For established plants, apply when plants have about 1 inch of new growth and then at 5 to 6 week intervals through the summer.

FOR NEW PLANTS: When planting new roses or shrubs, place about 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> level tablespoonfuls in the transplant hole as you refill. Mix an additional 21/2 tablespoonfuls into the top 2 inches of soil. Water thoroughly. Do not apply additional fertilizer for about 4 to 6 weeks.

FOR FLOWERS. BULBS AND BEDDING PLANTS: Apply 2 pounds of this product for each 100 square feet of flower and bed area. Work into the top 1 to 2 inches of soil. Place "sets" or seed in position and water the area thoroughly. Do not apply additional fertilizer for about 6 weeks. For bulbs, treat the soil surface in the bed at the planting depth and thoroughly mix. Set bulbs at the proper depth, cover with soil, then water.

FOR ESTABLISHED ROSES: Mix 1/2 cup into the soil around the base of each plant in a circle 2 inches from the base of the plant stem out 8 to 20 inches from the stem. Work into the top 1 to 2 inches of soil, and water thoroughly. Do not overdose since new tender growth may be injured.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS: For evergreen and deciduous shrubs, apply 1/2 cup for each foot of shrub height. Spread the required amount evenly over the soil from 2 to 3 inches from the base of the plant out to the drip line on all sides of the plants. Mix into the top 1 to 2 inches of soil and water in.

POTTED PLANTS OUTDOORS OR INDOORS:\* For treatment of potted plants, place granules on the surface of the soil and work into the soil. If there are many surface roots, punch holes into the soil around the outer rim of soil next to the container wall with a pencil, 2 to 4 inches deep to keep from injuring the roots. Evenly distribute the proper amount into these holes. After placing this product in the holes, fill each hole with soil. Smooth the soil surface and water as per the plant needs. Do not add additional fertilizer for at least 4 to 6 weeks.

#### HOW MUCH TO USE:

For a 6 inch diameter pot - use 1 level teaspoonful For a 10 inch diameter pot - use 1 level tablespoonful For a 12 to 14 inch diameter pot - use 1 1/2 to 2 level tablespoonfuls
