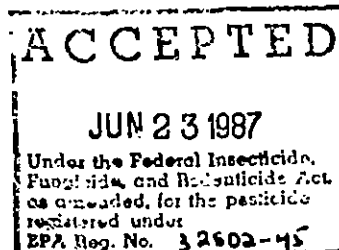

WHEN TO USE: Spray anytime during the growing season when weeds are actively growing, except as noted for Southern grasses. If lawn is extremely dry, water thoroughly 1 or 2 days before applying. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85 degrees F or if rain is expected within 24 hours of application. Do not apply to new lawns until new turf has been mowed at least three times. Do not reseed until three weeks after application.

Covers 5,000 square feet of turf when applied to bahia, bermuda, bluegrass, fescue, rye, and zoysia grasses.

Covers 7,500 square feet of turf when applied to St. Augustine, centipede, and bent grasses. Apply only in the spring and fall, and only when these grasses are actively growing. Some temporary damage may occur at this time.

DO NOT exceed recommended rate. Failure to comply with this may result in damage to the lawn.

DO NOT apply to Dichondra, Lippia or Clover. Application to any of these will cause lawn damage.

DO NOT use this product to control weeds in or near flower and vegetable gardens, shrubs, or ornamental plants.

DO NOT mow or water the lawn for at least 24 hours after application in order for the weed killer to penetrate the weed leaves.

After applying this Weed & Feed product, some weeds will begin to show curling and other visible signs of herbicide activity within two or three days. In the case of some hard to kill broadleaf weeds, a second application of this product, three to four weeks after the original application, may be necessary.

HOW TO USE AND APPLY

- (1) Shake container to ensure that all materials are dissolved.
- (2) Make sure the valve on the container is in the "OFF" position.
- (3) Connect the spray nozzle to the hose end.
- (4) Remove the container cap and screw the container to the spray nozzle.
- (5) Turn on water at the tap.

(6) Turn the valve on the nozzle to the "ON" position and begin a sweeping motion of the spray on the lawn. You may wish to practice this motion before you actually start applying the Weed and Feed (by placing nozzle on hose without Weed & Feed container and spraying plain water).

(7) Begin application at the point farthest from the hose shut-off and work backwards toward the shut-off. Overlap slightly as you spray the lawn, keeping the spray pointed slightly downward.

Just fasten to your hose end and follow the easy to understand instructions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. To be stored in original container and placed in a locked area inaccessible to children. 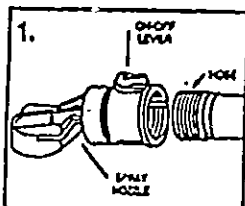

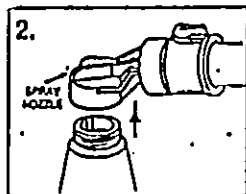

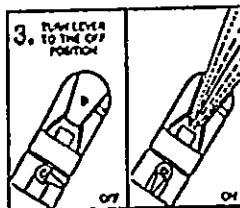
HOW TO USE SPRAYER



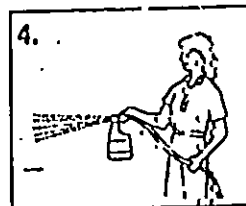
Connect spray nozzle to hose.



Remove bottle cap and screw bottle into nozzle.



Turn the on/off lever on top of the nozzle to the OFF position. Turn on the water at the tap. When ready to treat, turn the on/off lever to its ON position. The Liquid Weed and Feed will mix automatically at the proper ratio.



Slowly walk back and forth at a steady pace. Overlap slightly for uniform coverage. Marks on right side panel indicate square foot coverage.
