"BIRD CAUTION: While avian toxicology studies have shown low acute toxicity to birds, the potential for avian reproduction effects is being evaluated. To reduce potential exposure to birds, do not apply this product in split applications; make only one application per season; do not apply more tha 0.5 lbs. of A.I. per acre. Avoid known bird nesting sites and areas where birds are actively feeding when applying this product."

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS WHEN APPLYING

Cultural practices such as aeration, dethatching, and verticutting should be completed and the turf allowed to recover before application of this product. Irrigation or rainfall within 7 days after application may improve weed control.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS WHEN APPLYING (Cont.)

- This product should be applied 7 to 14 days prior to the seed germination of annual grasses and/or broadleaf weeds.
- New lawn and/or seedling growth may be inhibited if surface seeding or sprigging is done within 4 months after an application. Use a "Slit Seeder" or equivalent for best results.
- This product may be applied to any healthy well established turfgrass that has been seeded, sodded, or sprigged. Use on turf that is poorly established, weakened, or mechanically stressed may increase the potential for delayed recovery.
- Do not apply over-the-top of desirable flowers, vegetables shrubs or trees.
- Do not use clippings from treated turf for animal feed or for mulching around fruit trees, flowers, shrubs, or vegetables.
- Do not allow domestic animals to feed or forage on the treated turf.
- For control of annual bluegrass and winter annuals, apply in the fall of the year prior to their seed germination.
- Do not use this product on putting greens.
