In the State of New York: For use by professional turf application only, at no more than 10.74 lbs per 1000 square feet per year (0.5 pounds A.I. per acre per year). Not for use in Nassau or Suffolk Counties.

PROXY INFORMATION: This product contains turf fertilizer plus a selective herbicide for control of crabgrass and other annual grasses and broadleaf weeds in established lawns and ornamental turf. Apply this product only to selected, sodded, or sprigged turf that is well established. Turf must develop a good root system and uniform stand, and have received at least two mowings following seeding, sodding or sprigging before making the first application of this product. Use of this product on turf that is not well established, or weakened by weather, pests or other stress, may increase the chance of turf injury. In addition, this product provides "early post-emergence" control during the early stages of growth when crabgrass is most vulnerable to control. This early post-emergence crabgrass control is limited, and post-emergence applications are only effective if applied before crabgrass has displayed its fifth leaf or first tiller (which generally corresponds to the time when you can first see the crabgrass plants in the lawn). The benefit of this post-emergence activity is that it gives the user a 2 to 4 week longer period of time to make applications for effective control of crabgrass.

WHERE TO USE: This product may be used on the following established turfgrasses: Carpeting Bentgrass* (Agrostis palustris), Kentucky Bluegrass (Poa pratensis), Annual Ryegrass (Lolium perenne), Bermuda Grass (Cynodon dactylon), Centipedegrass (Erenochloa ophioides), Bermudagrass (Cynodon dactylon), Buffalograss** (Bouteloua inodora), Carpetgrass (Axonopus compressus), Zoysiagrass (Zoysia japonica), St. Augustine (Stenotaphrum secundatum), St. Augustine (Stenotaphrum secundatum), Zoysiagrass (Zoysia japonica), *Turfgrasses injury may result from use of this product on certain varieties of creeping bentgrass, such as Coburney, Carmen, Seaside and Washington.
