The label amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended are acceptable provided that you make the following changes:

- 1) The "GENERAL INFORMATION" header on page 1 must be replaced with "PRODUCT INFORMATION".
- 2) Assure that the net weight of the product is expressed in pounds (lbs.) on page 1 of the product label.
- 3) Per the Label Review Manual, the Container Disposal statement in the Storage and Disposal box on page 2 must read as follows:  
"Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then offer for recycling if available or dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke."
- 4) The Container Disposal statement for household use product must read as follows:  
Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place any unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."
- 5) Per the Label Review Manual, the phrase "To the extent consistent with applicable law" must be added to the beginning of the third sentence in the first alternate WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER paragraph on page 2 for the statement to read:  
"To the extent consistent with applicable law, manufacturer/seller makes no other warranty, expressed or implied, and shall not be liable for indirect or consequential damages."


- 6) Per the Label Review Manual, the phrase “To the extent consistent with applicable law” must be added to the beginning of the third, fourth, and fifth sentences in the second alternate WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER paragraph on page 2. Add the text in bold for the paragraph to read:
- “WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER: Manufacturer/seller warrants that this product conforms to the ingredient statement on the label, and that the product is reasonably suited for the labeled use when applied according to directions. Buyer and user assumes all risks and liability of use, storage and/or handling of this product not in accordance with the terms of this label. **To the extent consistent with applicable law**, no other warranty, expressed or implied, is made concerning the merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. **To the extent consistent with applicable law**, manufacturer’s/seller’s liability shall be limited to the purchase price of the product. **To the extent consistent with applicable law**, in no case shall manufacturer/seller be liable for consequential or incidental damages or loss.”
- 7) Per the Label Review Manual, the phrase “To the extent consistent with applicable law” must be added to the beginning of the fourth and seventh sentences in the alternate NOTICE paragraph on page 2. Additionally, the phrase “Except as expressly provided” must replace the phrase “Except as warranted by this label” at the beginning of the sixth sentence. Add the text in bold for the statements to read:
- “**To the extent consistent with applicable law**, in no case shall manufacturer/seller be liable for consequential, special or indirect damages resulting from the use or handling of this product. All such risks shall be assumed by the buyer. **Except as warranted by this label**, manufacturer/seller makes no other warranties or representations, expressed or implied, or by usage of trade, statutory or otherwise, including, but not limited to, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, use or eligibility of the product for any particular trade usage. **To the extent consistent with applicable law**, buyer’s or user’s exclusive remedy for loss or damage resulting from this product shall be limited to the cost of the product.”
- 8) The marketing claim on page 2 that reads “No Phosphate Formula” may only be used if this product contains no phosphate. If the product contains phosphate, this claims must be deleted from the label. Note: The Guaranteed Analysis box on page 1 must list 0.00% phosphate in order for this claim to be used.
- 9) The marketing claim on page 2 that reads “Phosphate Free fertilizer” may only be used if this product contains no phosphate. If the product contains phosphate, this claim must be deleted from the label. Note: The Guaranteed Analysis box on page 1 must list 0.00% phosphate in order for this claim to be used.

- 10) Correct the typographical error on page 2 replacing “springf” with “spring” for the claim to read “Apply in early spring, or before germination.
- 11) Delete the claim on page 2 that reads “Specially formulated for Minnesota”.  
Note: Using a state-specific claim of this nature on a product label requires justification.
- 12) NOTE: While the Agency is not requesting additional data at this time, you must maintain data in your files supporting marketing and/or efficacy claims made on the product label. If no substantiating data are available, you must delete the claim from the product label.
- 13) NOTE: Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Products shipped after 18 months from the date on this notice or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of this product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. This label supersedes all previous accepted labels.
