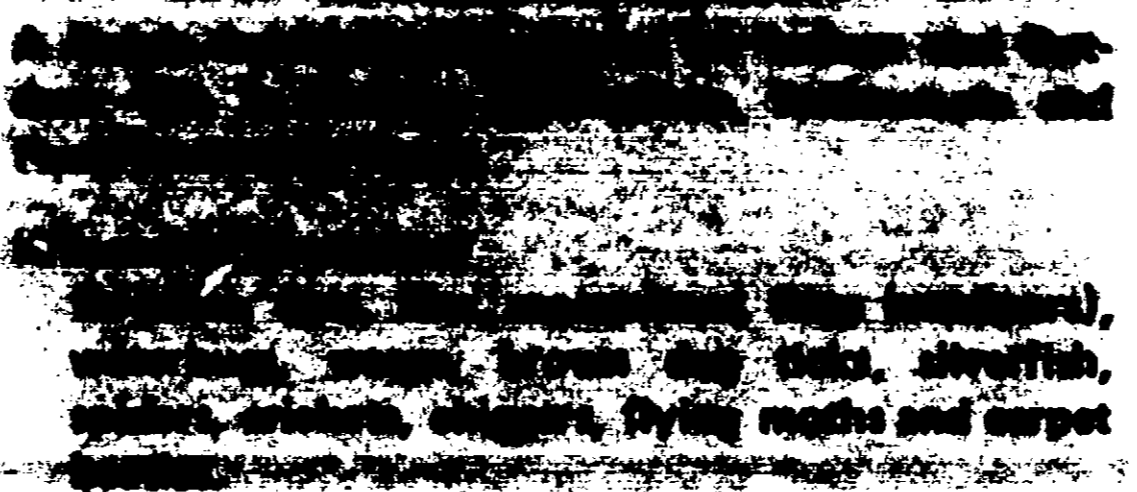

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spray infested surfaces until wet.

ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS: Spray heavily into all cracks, crevices, and other places where they insects hide. Also behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray edge of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall coverings. Applications should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. **DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH FORMULATION.**

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures or porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas, spray weeds and bushy non-crop areas around the home thoroughly. Avoid spraying desirable plants. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as reinfestations occur.
