**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CHEMCIDE SBA is used to control bacteria, algae, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of \_\_\_\_\_ fluid ounces of CHEMCIDE SBA per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 96 parts per million of CHEMCIDE SBA is recommended.

Subsequent slug additions of 3.6 fluid ounces of CHEMCIDE SBA per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 240 parts per million of CHEMCIDE SBA is recommended.

Repeat initial dosages until control is effected. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump.

CHEMCIDE SBA is used for air-washing systems that maintain effective mist to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 49.95 fluid ounces of CHEMCIDE SBA per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Repeat initial dosage until control is effected. Subsequent slug additions of 33.75 to 83.25 fluid ounces of CHEMCIDE SBA per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the collection trays of the airwash system.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
