The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable with comments provided for labeling.

The submitted data demonstrate the effectiveness of this product as a virucide against HIV-1 (AIDS virus) on hard, non-porous surfaces in the presence of organic soil (5% serum) when applied at a dilution of 1:64 in 459 ppm hard water at room temperature (20-25 degree centigrade) with a contact time of two minutes.

Regarding the labeling comments, on the left panel, change "Hard surface disinfection...."to read "Hard non-porous surface disinfection..." Under "Directions For Use" change the following:

a. Change "use at 2 ounces..."to read "use 2 ounces..."

b. Change the statement "the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi" to read "the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton mentagrophytes".

c. Change the statement "apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces" to read "apply to walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces".

d. Change the statement "surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes to read "Surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes and allow to air dry".

e. Change the statement "AD-BAC 4227 when used on environmental inanimate hard surfaces...to read "AD-BAC 4227 when used on environmental inanimate hard non-porous surfaces..."

This product must not be used to clean the following food contact surfaces: utensils, glassware and dishes. No Restricted Use Classification is recommended.
