### Dear Ms Findell:

The revised subject labels that you submitted on April 8, 2003 in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended are acceptable provided the following changes are made to both labels:

## First Aid

Put the text for the First Aid section in a separate block (POND BLOCK)

Move the sentence "Do not induce vomiting..." from the header to the block next to "If swallowed"

After the sentence "Call a poison control...." add the following sentence: "Have the product container label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment."

In the block "If in eyes" change the first sentence to read "Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes."

In the block "If on skin" change the second sentence to read "Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes."

### Storage and Disposal

Change the heading "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage"

Pond Block and Fountain Block Page 2 of 2

Change the section "Disposal" to read: "Pesticide Disposal: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain. Container Disposal: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available."

One copy of each label stamped "Accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records.

Please submit one copy of each final printed label before the product is released for shipment.



Under the Federal Insecticide, Fundicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the penticide registered under EPA, Reg. No. 3 3 0 3 4 Peg. No.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Fountain Block is limited for use in backyard/homeowner water fountains and ponds (maximum 3000 U.S. gallons [11355 L]). Do not use fish from treated fountains or ponds for food or feed. Fountain Block helps clear cloudy water and remove algae from ornamental fountain/pond water. USE ONE BLOCK FOR WATER VOLUMES BETWEEN 30 AND 80 U.S. GALLONS (110 L - 300 L). Initial dose may require one block for each 30 U.S. gallons (110 L). For regular maintenance, replace block when fully dissolved (usually after 10 days). Not recommended for use with live plants.

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

**Storage:** Store in an area inaccessible to children, water supplies and feed.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.


