USE ONE BLOCK FOR WATER VOLUMES BETWEEN 100 AND 250 U.S. GALLONS (380 L – 950 L). Initial dose may require one block for each 100 U.S. gallons (380 L). For regular maintenance, replace block when fully dissolved (usually after 30 days). Not recommended for use with live plants.
