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2 Under the subheading entitled STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (SOPT)

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce Vomiting.

OR

IF SWALLOWED; Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If the person is unconscious do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.


IF ON SKIN: wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical Attention if irritation persists.
