Re: NOTIFICATION OF NON-FIFRA RELATED TEXT CHANGE

Dear Mr. Tompkins:

Jungle Laboratories wishes to notify the Agency of the addition of a word to the label text. Specifically, the text addition is as follows:

On line 6 of Paragraph 2, we changed "Do not use in water fountains and patio ponds with live plants . . ." to *"Do not use in tanks, water fountains, or patio ponds with live plants . . ."*

The word "tanks" originally appeared on the label; but was inadvertently left out of a previous notification. Both of these changes are highlighted in yellow.

In addition to this text change, we moved *"FOR AQUARIUMS AND CONTAINERIZED PONDS ONLY"* from the bottom of the label to the top of the label.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 USC Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under Sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
