HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, with effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after spraying. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Swallowed — Get prompt medical attention.
- If Inhaled — Get fresh air.
- If on Skin — Flush with water. Wash with warm water and soap.
- If in Eyes — Flush thoroughly with water.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wash container and out in wash container. Do not incinerate.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

IMPORTANT: Contains solvents that may affect plastics, rubber and painted surfaces if spray is concentrated onto these surfaces. Check inconspicuous areas before using.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 8 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects directly with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants, treat doors, window sills, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for control.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray at as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Borers and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas: Remove and destroy animals bedding and spray sleeping quarters freely. Direct spray into cracks and crevices. Allow spray to dry and replace clean bedding. Do not spray animals directly. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps: Contact insects directly with spray. Sweep up and discard fallen wasps. Repeat as necessary.
