DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner not labeled with its labeling.

Non-abrasive. Will not harm hard-surface materials including walls, woodwork, cabinets, floors, tiles, wall panels, linoleum, vinyl floors, window blinds, chrome and stainless steel, glass, mirrors, refrigerators, freezers, sinks, appliances, radiators, ceramic counter and toilet tops.

For use in hospitals, schools, hotels, motels, restaurants and offices.

Excellent for disinfecting and deodorizing. Leaves areas clean and fresh smelling.

For disinfecting a pre-cleaned step is required. When used as directed, this product demonstrates effective disinfection on pre-cleaned, hard, non-porous substrates against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella enteritidis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa, thus meeting requirements for hospital use.

TO CLEAN

- (1) Shake can before using.
- (2) Hold can at a slight angle from surface to be cleaned.
- (3) Spray area until covered with a white foam.
- (4) Allow foam to penetrate and wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge. No scrubbing is necessary. For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before using.

This product will not leave grit or soap spon.

Special valve allows product to be sprayed in an inverted position for up to seven seconds to help clean in hard to reach places. After seven seconds return to upright position, shake well and continue spraying as before.

**TO DISINFECT
AND DEODORIZE
PRE-CLEANED SURFACES**

- (1) Follow directions as above and allow foam to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing is necessary. Then wipe with a clean cloth, mop or sponge.

**TO CONTROL MOLD
AND MILDEW**

On pre-cleaned hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, toilet bowls) spray surfaces to be treated making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mold growth reappears.

If used on food surfaces, surfaces must be scrubbed with a detergent and rinsed with potable water before reusing.
