Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.

**DO NOT:** Apply to surfaces including garbage cans, landfills, air ducts (in use), chimneys and waterfalls, oil tanks, boiler rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, may electric and storage (after emptying or filling). Pity to application, use of standard equipment. After application, allow time for it to evaporate before starting repairs or painting surfaces by the "DO" portion.

**Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into air.** Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**DO NOT:** Apply to animal quarters, food handling, food and food storage and any areas where food may hide. If left undisturbed, a deposit will continue to kill bugs for several weeks. Repeat application when after-treatment is required.

**DO NOT:** Apply to: Toys, bed, sport and food courts, beds and interior of equipment. Materials should be treated, especially beds, beds and sport. Do not use in hospital patient quarters.

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
