The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. For the record, submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula including the pH if applicable and the bulk density of the product.
2. Delete the phrase "(allyl homolog of Cinerin i)", which appears in the active ingredient statement.
3. Revise the label so that the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement appears in the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section, directly beneath the **PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS** statement.

It has been noted for the record that the child-resistant packaging has been removed from this product.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled, with a detergent followed by a potable water rinse. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Get prompt medical attention. Do not induce vomiting.
IF INHALED: Get Fresh air. Get medical attention. **IF ON SKIN:** Flush with water. Wash with warm water and soap. **IF IN EYES:** Flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment, ventilate for two hours. Post-treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not incinerate empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE SPRAYING.
HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.**

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, AND FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, AND ANTS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks, pipes and other hiding areas, biting insects directly. Spray ant hills and trails over door sills, around window frames, and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

May stain finished surfaces and fabrics if sprayed too closely. 10.91
