The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise the "If Swallowed" First aid Statement to read as follows:
If swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Revise the directions for use in food serving areas to read as follows:
Remove food from food serving areas of commercial establishments prior to treatment. Wash all exposed food serving/handling surfaces thoroughly with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after treatment and before use.

Revise the directions for use in homes as follows:
In homes, remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces, and wash thoroughly after treatment and before use.

In the directions for use to kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats and flying moths, delete the last sentence, which says to cover exposed food and utensils. This statement contradicts required detailed instructions to protect food from contamination.

Move the emergency medical information number to the first aid statements, in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

*Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains petroleum distillates - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **IF EMPTY:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **IF PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE SPRAYING. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Not for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

NOTE: When used in hospitals patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, AND FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room 1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, AND ANTS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks, pipes and other hiding areas, hitting insects directly. Spray ant hills and trails over door sills, around window frames and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control. May stain finished surfaces and fabrics if sprayed too closely.
