The new basic confidential statement of formula (CSF) dated 2/14/07 referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A copy has been placed in the file jacket for this registration and supercedes all previous basic CSFs.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

Move the statement "Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying" to a subsection entitled "Use Restrictions" under the Directions for Use.

Add an emergency telephone number to the First Aid Statements. See PR Notice 2001-1.

Move the text beginning with "Do not use in food/feed areas..." and ending with "...until after ventilation." to the "Use Restrictions" subsection.

Qualify the directions to kill ants to read as follows "...ants except pharaoh, carpenter, harvester and fire ants".

Delete "for control" from the directions to kill roaches.


In the directions for killing flies mosquitoes and gnats and flying moths, revise the first sentence as follows:

Close all door and windows and turn off ventilation systems...

Delete "and other locations" from the directions for use.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**FIRST AID STATEMENTS: IF SWALLOWED:** Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE SPRAYING. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Remove food from food serving areas of commercial establishments prior to treatment. Wash all exposed food serving/handling surfaces thoroughly with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after treatment and before use. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). In the home, remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces, and wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Not for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

**NOTE:** When used in hospitals patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

**TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, AND FLYING MOTHS:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

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**TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, AND ANTS:** Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks, pipes and other hiding areas, hitting insects directly. Spray ant hills and trails over door sills, around window frames and other locations. Repeat as necessary for control.

May stain finished surfaces and fabrics if sprayed too closely.
