APPLICATION

Functions as a microbistat (fungi, bacterial) for use in industrial and/or commercial air circulating cooling water towers, air washer, and/or evaporative condenser.

Always apply at a point in the system where the product will be uniformly mixed, such as basin of cooling tower, air washer, or evaporative condenser.

Begin treatment when the system is in jeopardy of becoming affected, or after cleaning the system, where efficiency is already impaired.

DOSAGE Intermittent or Slug Method

Initial dose: 40-80 ppm active sodium chlorophenates. When the system is noticeably fouled, apply 10-20 gallons of #313 per 120,000 gallons of water in the system (80-160 ppm) of the product. Repeat until control is achieved.

Subsequent dose: 20-40 ppm active sodium chlorophenates. When microbial control is evident, add 5 to 10 gallons of #313 per 120,000 gallons of water in the system (40 to 80 ppm of the product) every week, or as needed to maintain control. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply to water that will be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, rivers, or other bodies of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
