The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. Repeat this procedure two more times. Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into a storage container or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down

over storage container or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling, if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
