STORAGE & DISPOSAL. Chlorine Cylinders are designed for reuse and must be returned to the supplier. Cylinders must not be stored where they will be exposed to temperatures warmer than 54.5°C (130°F). Cylinders to be returned should be identified with DOT Tag or label and shipped in accordance with suppliers instructions. Pesticide wastes are accurally trazardous. Improper disposal of excess posticide, spray mixture, or rinsale is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state Pesticide or Environmental Contral Agency or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance. HE SAME TEMPERATURE AS OTHER CONTAINERS CONNECTED TO THE SYSTEM. Use chlorine containers in the order received. Weigh container on a platform scale when unloading. NEVER HEAT CHLORINE CONTAINERS OR VALVES, DON'T PLACE THEM IN A HOT WATER BATH TO INCREASE DISCHARGE RATES. Be sure no water or other figuid is sucked back leds container due to pressure differences, especially when it is nearly empty. NEVER LEAVE CONTAINER VALVES OPEN WHEN CHLORINE IS NOT BEING USED. Use only valves, gauges, regulators, fittings, piping, etc., recommended for chlorine service. Netly the chlorine supplier promptly of damaged containers. NEVER TAMPER WITH FUSIBLE PLUGS OR ATTEMPT TO ALTER OR REPAIR CONTAINERS OR VALVES.
