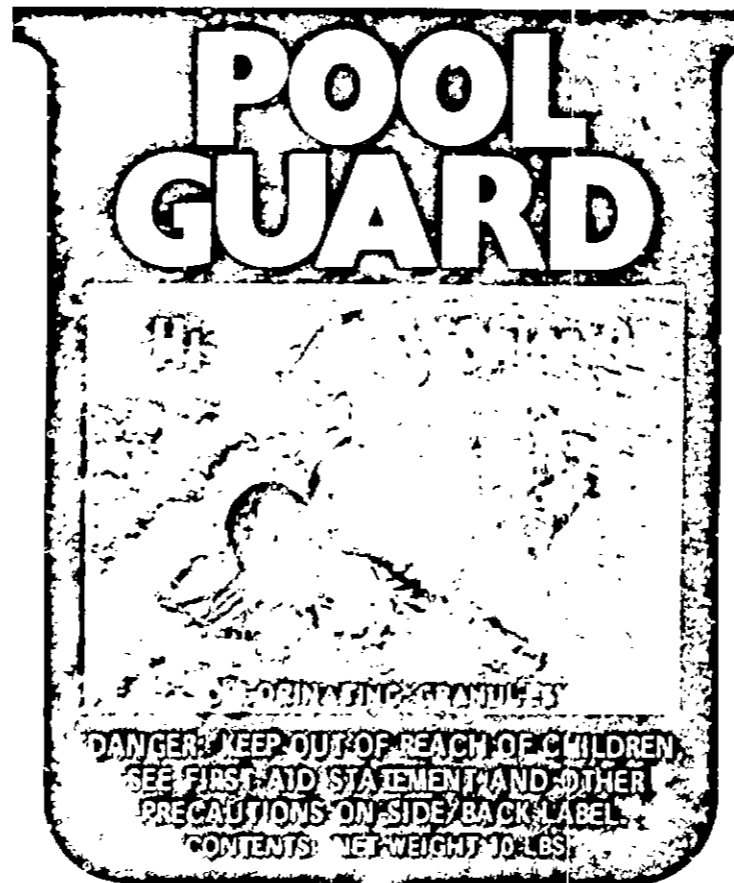

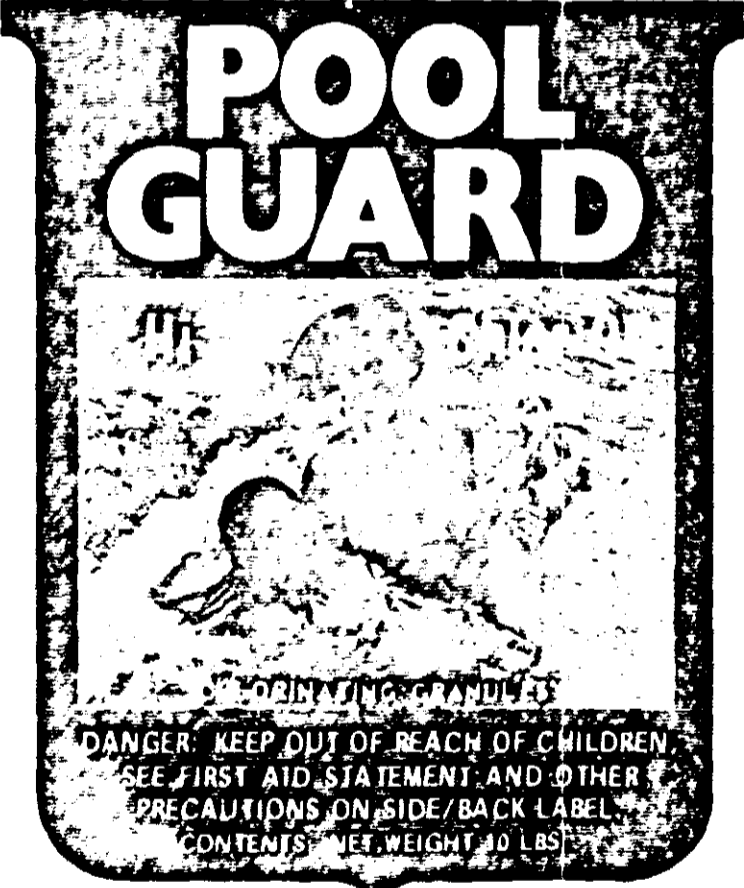

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a fast acting formula to use this product
without the chlorine.

1. Add 1/2 cup per 10,000 gallons as determined by a
water test kit. (Using best jet faucet, 7.6
p.p.m. chlorine. If previously stabilized
with cyanuric acid, follow the directions
on the label.)

2. When pool is shocked, add 3 ounces
granules per every 10,000 gallons of water.
Shock water to a chlorine residual of 7.0 to 7.5
p.p.m. as determined by the use of a
water test kit. (Using best jet faucet, 7.6
p.p.m. chlorine. If there is no
cyanuric acid, repeat dosage daily until
a residual of 3 p.p.m. is found on the following
day. If using cyanuric acid, repeat dosage every
10 days or as needed to maintain
between 2.0 p.p.m. and 2.5 p.p.m. at all times.)

3. If cyanuric acid is used, the pH of Pool
Guard granules will tend to reduce the
pH of pool water. Proper pH should be maintained
by the addition of a test kit, by periodic
addition of sodium bicarbonate.

STORAGE & SPECIAL: Keep product dry in tight
sealed plastic container in a cool, dry, well
ventilated area. In case of decomposition,
do not use. Do not mix with other
chemicals. Do not use in areas where
children or pets may come in contact with it.
Do not use in areas where food is prepared
or stored.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

If required by applicable Federal Law, use the product and manner of use only as labeled on this label.

1. Before using, test the water for pH. A pH of 7.2 to 7.6 is determined by a test kit for acids with a range including test pH for 7.0 to 7.6.

2. Apply Pool Guard 43 Granules to a properly stabilized and conditioned swimming pool. Follow the directions for use on the label for that label.

3. When the pool is treated, add 2 ounces of Pool Guard 43 Granules for every 5,000 gallons of water. Repeat the above procedure when the residual chlorine level has been reduced to 1 ppm. If required by the use of a chlorine test kit, the amount of Pool Guard 43 Granules should be sufficient to satisfy raw water demand and maintain a residual level of 1.0 ppm. Repeat this procedure daily until a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm is found on the following day. The matter of Pool Guard 43 Granules for every 5,000 gallons of water should be added to maintain a residual level of 1.0 ppm and 2.0 ppm at all times as determined by the test kit. Please note: The pH of Pool Guard 43 Granules should be checked and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at pH 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test kit. Periodic adjustment of alkalinity should be made.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from fire, heat, and direct sunlight. Do not use, except in swimming pools, and keep away from children and pets. Do not use for disposal. Do not mix with water or other material unless directed on label. Do not wash hands or clothing with water. Material should be disposed of in a safe manner as approved and directed by your local health department.
