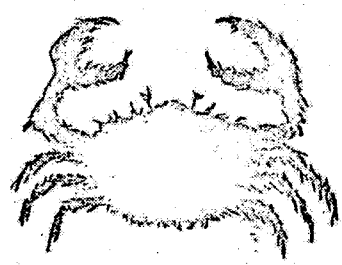

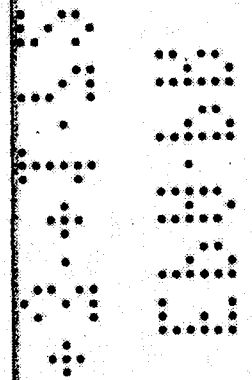

1. Prevents the emergence of crabgrass seedlings without harming the desirable turfgrasses listed below;
2. Prevents seedlings of Foxtail and Barnyard grass from emerging.
3. Permits safe seeding of your lawn while controlling crabgrass at the same time.

HOW TO USE

1. For use on newly seeded or established plantings of the following grasses:

Bluegrass	Bentgrass-Strains as follows:
Fescue	Pennecross
Redtop	Seaside
Smooth Brome	Highland
Perennial Rye	Astoria
Orchardgrass	Nimisla
Zoysia	C-1, C-7, and C-19

DO NOT USE on other Bentgrass strains or Bermuda grass.

2. Rake lawn to remove leaves and other debris.
3. On Established Lawns—apply at the rate of 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (10 lb. bag covers 2,500 sq. ft.). Apply after the 1st or 2nd mowing (usually at the time forsythia blossoms start to fall) in the spring before crabgrass and other annual grass weeds emerge.
4. On Newly Seeded Areas—apply at the rate of 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (10 lb. bag covers 5,000 sq. ft.). Apply immediately after seeding in early spring before crabgrass and other annual grass weeds emerge.
5. Apply with fertilizer spreader (see settings below) to insure even coverage.
6. If it does not rain for three days after application, water the treated area thoroughly to get desired results. Timing application just ahead of a predicted rain is ideal.
