DIRECTIONS FOR USE FOR CONTROLLING THE GROWTH OF SLIME (fungi, algae, bacteria induced slime) IN INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS.

1. Clean badly fouled system.
2. Before or when algae (slime) is first noticed, add an initial dosage of 0.5-1.0 lbs. of OLIN 3101 per 1,000 gals. of water directly to the cooling tower drip pan near the inlet to the recirculating pump to obtain control. Repeat if necessary until control is evident, following the initial dosage recommendation.
3. When control is evident, add subsequent treatments weekly or as needed of 0.185 to 0.37 lbs. of OLIN 3101 per 1,000 gallons of water in the system to maintain control.

OLIN 3101 is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
