Begin treatment when the system is cleaned. After cleaning systems with biocides, systems must be cleaned before Olin 3302 is applied. Feed at a point in the system where the water is well mixed.

INITIAL DOSE: Apply 1.0 oz. (20 ppm) per 100 gal. of water. Repeat at 10-day intervals until growth of slime-forming organisms is stopped.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When growth of slime-forming organisms is stopped, apply 0.5 oz. (10 ppm) per 100 gal. of water. If needed, apply 0.5 oz. (10 ppm) per 100 gal. of water.

INDUSTRIAL CIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

Begin treatment when the system is in jeopardy of becoming affected or after cleaning systems whose efficiency is already impaired. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun. For best results, pump feed at a point in the system where the product will be well mixed.

INITIAL DOSE: Apply 13.06 fl. oz. OLIN 3302 per 1,000 gal. water in system (120 ppm). Repeat weekly or more frequently if necessary to control growth of slime forming organisms.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When control is evident, add 2.19 fl. oz. OLIN 3302 per 1,000 gal. water in system (20-40 ppm) every 30 days or as needed.
