DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before use hold container upright

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered. As you spray, fluff the fur so spray will penetrate to the skin. To kill ticks the spray must contact them directly.

DO NOT SPRAY INTO THE EYES, FACE OR ON THE GENITALS.

For cats apply at the rate of one second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 second per pound of body weight for thin or short hair dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound for long or thick haired dogs.

For animals with very heavy fur it may be necessary to spray against the lay of the hair. Do not use on very young (under 6 weeks) animals.
