LAWN CHINCH BUG AND SOD WEBWORM CONTROL

DIRECTIONS: To control Chinch Bugs and Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths), apply at 1 pound per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn area. After application, water lawn using - 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn area. For Chinch Bugs, apply when activity or damage appears (yellowing then browning of grass often develops in spots then spreads throughout the lawn). Control will last up to eight weeks. To prevent damage apply as soon as daily temperatures reach 80 degrees F. and repeat every 2 months. NOTE: for control of white grubs (larva of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle) use at 2 - 4 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. where infestation occurs. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July or August. Consult your local Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area. Apply Lawn Medic uniformly with a spreader and water immediately. Do not mow lawn for 24 hours following treatment.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: "Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in safe place away from water supplies."
