

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE  
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in dry place. Keep away from fire or sparks. Storage area should be ventilated and posted with signs showing danger warning-Pesticide storage-keep out. Keep container closed.

ORNAMENTAL TURF**

**DIRECTIONS:** For Control of Chinch Bug and Sod Webworms: Lawn Medics apply at 1 pound per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn area. After application, water lawn using 1-30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn area. For Chinch Bugs, apply when activity or damage appears (yellowing then browning of grass often develops in spots then spreads throughout the lawn). Control will last up to eight weeks. To prevent damage apply as soon as daily temperatures reach 80 degrees F. and repeat every 2 months. **NOTE:** for control of white grubs (larva of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle) use at 1-2 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. where infestation occurs. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July or August. Consult your local Co-operative Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area. Apply Lawn Medic uniformly with a spreader and water immediately. Do not mow lawn for 24 hours following treatment.
