On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. - 2. You will submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the use is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1 and ends September 30. The production information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15 following the end of the preceding fiscal year.

You will submit protocols prior to conducting the above studies for Agency review and approval.

- 4. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
  - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 33657-8".
- b. Qualify the use sites as follows, "Use in Homes, apartment buildings, and the non-food/feed areas of hotels, warehouses ... etc.
- 5. You will submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment.

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy all applicable conditions, this <u>conditional</u> registration will expire automatically on March 1, 2004. Sale and distribution of the subject product bearing labeling for residential sites, commercial and industrial establishments and institutions after March 1, 2004 will be illegal.

Finally, once the required data have been submitted and evaluated, EPA will entertain an application to amend the registration of the subject product to allow unconditional use in residential sites, commercial and industrial establishment and institutions.

Pillbugs (Sowbugs), and Exposed Stages of Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles and Cigarette Beetles. The penetrating fog kills even hidden pests. Fleas in carpets, rugs, upholstery, pet bedding and floor cracks will be killed. 1% Etofenprox Fogger leaves no lingering, unpleasant odor or sticky mess, and will not stain furnishings when used as directed.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

## READ THE ENTIRE LABEL PRIOR TO USE. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL LABEL PRECAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

Note: Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply to patient rooms in hospitals and nursing homes while occupied. For use in the non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed handling establishments. Do not use in food or feed areas of food or feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or the facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Remove food from food serving areas of commercial establishments prior to treatment. Wash all exposed food serving/handling surfaces thoroughly with potable water following treatment and before use. In homes, remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces and wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Repeated exposure to etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

Non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed establishments are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling).

For best results, treat entire dwelling with particular attention to kitchen and bathroom areas. Use only one fogger for each 750 sq. ft. (25' x 30' area or 6,000 cubic feet) of floor space.

Close outside doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counter or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fogs to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Open interior doors and closets of area to be treated. Open all cupboards and drawers and remove contents. Remove pets and birds. Tightly cover fish aquariums.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

Place can in the middle of the room, on a stand, table, chair or on the floor. Place several layers of unfolded newspaper, covering a 2 sq. ft. area directly under can to prevent marring of surface. Keeping at arm's length, point top of can away from face and press down actuator tab to lock into position and release fogging action. Set can in an upright position and leave treated area for at least two hours. Also, remove pets and keep out of treated area for at least 2 hours. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows, turn on air conditioners and fans and ventilate the treated area for 30 minutes.

**NOTE:** Asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected by this product. Place newspaper on asphalt tile before treatment and cover plastic items such as plastic furniture, stereo covers, eye glasses, etc.

Repeat treatments to infested areas as necessary at intervals of 14 days or greater. Do not make more than 6 applications per site per year.
