You will submit protocols prior to conducting the above studies for Agency review and approval.

4. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 33657-9".
- b. Qualify the use sites as follows, "Use in Homes, apartment buildings, and the non-food/feed areas of hotels, warehouses ... etc
- c. Delete "Retreat as necessary" from the labeling.

5. You will submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment.

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy all applicable conditions, this conditional registration will expire automatically on March 1, 2004. Sale and distribution of the subject product bearing labeling for residential sites, commercial and industrial establishments and institutions after March 1, 2004 will be illegal.

Finally, once the required data have been submitted and evaluated, EPA will entertain an application to amend the registration of the subject product to allow unconditional use in residential sites, commercial and industrial establishment and institutions.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ THE ENTIRE LABEL PRIOR TO USE. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL LABEL PRECAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS.**

**Note:** Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply to patient rooms in hospitals and nursing homes while occupied. For use in the non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed handling establishments. Do not use in food or feed areas of food or feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or the facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Remove food from food serving areas of commercial establishments prior to treatment. Wash all exposed food serving/handling surfaces thoroughly with potable water following treatment and before use. In homes, remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces and wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Repeated exposure to etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

Non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed establishments are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling).

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 2 seconds to treat approximately 1 linear foot of baseboard area).

For best results, treat entire dwelling with particular attention to kitchen and bathroom areas.

#### **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE**

**Repeat treatments to infested areas as necessary at intervals of 14 days or greater. Do not make more than 6 applications per site per year.**

**For Fleas and Ticks:** Treat all baseboard areas and room perimeters, as well as cracks and crevices in hard surface floors. Spot treat additional areas where fleas may be present. These areas include under furniture, under the edges of floor coverings, dark corners, and favorite resting spots or other places your pet frequents. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Provide a good, even treatment, but do not soak the areas you treat. Humans and pets should avoid contact with treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

A total management program best controls fleas. It is suggested that infested areas be thoroughly vacuumed prior to treatment. The vacuum cleaner bag should be discarded immediately in an outdoor trash container. Continue to discard vacuum cleaner bags until flea infestation has been brought under control. For effective flea control, it is very important to control the source of the flea infestation. This can require treatment of pets with a product registered for flea control and treatment of outdoor areas frequented by pets or infested areas.

**For Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs (Pillbugs) and Spiders:** Spray areas where these pests are found, or hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards, door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding should be sprayed directly. **For Ants:** Apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else ants may find entrance. Retreat as necessary.

**Carpet Beetles:** Apply as a spot application along baseboards and edges of carpeting; under carpeting, rugs and furniture; and in closets or shelving where these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame and preferably in an area inaccessible to children and pets.

**Disposal:** This container may be recycled at aerosol recycling centers. At present, there are only a few such centers in the country. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label (DO NOT PUNCTURE!). If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.
