On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) and (B) provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
 - 2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration Number 33657-15".
 - b. Add the following statement to the beginning of Precautionary Statement paragraph: "Caution: Harmful if swallowed."

- c. Delete the heading "General Information". This term is too broad, and not enforceable.
- d. Add "outdoor" to the first bulleted statement under GENERAL INFORMATION, to read as follows: "For outdoor use in the following areas".
- e. Add a disclaimer for pharaoh, harvester, and carpenter ants to the general ant claim.
- f. Delete all reference to control of flying insects, gnats, and small flying moths. A residual control for flying insects has not been demonstrated for this chemical.
- g. Revise the first sentence in the first paragraph under the heading OUTDOOR PEST CONTROL to read as follows: "Do not spray when wind conditions could create a mist to blow back to applicator."
- h. Delete the following areas for surface spray: "open porches, patio areas, screens, doors." These are direct human contact areas, and a risk assessment for direct human contact has not been conducted for Dinotefuran.
- i. Add the following to the beginning of the second and third sentences in the warranty statement titled as "Conditions of Sale" on page 4: "to the extent consistent with applicable law,....."
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(a). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. A copy of the storage stability review is also enclosed for your perusal.

GENERAL INFORMATION

· For use in the following areas:

Ant Hills (except fire ants) and Ornamental Plants

Controls the following flying and crawling insects:

Ants (except fire ants), Crickets, Small Flying Moths, Gnats

• Hold container upright. Do not spray up into the air. Turn sprayer nozzle to "on" position. Hold approximately 12 inches from surface to be sprayed. Squeeze trigger to spray until surface is slightly moist.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

OUTDOOR PEST CONTROL

Caution should be taken to avoid spraying when wind conditions could create a mist to blow back to applicator. Spray the surface areas and contact as many insects as possible. Do not apply this product in or around bodies of water.

Gnats and small flying moths: Hold container 12-18 inches from shrubs, bushes, grassy areas and other areas infested with these pests. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat surfaces of open porches, patio area, screens, window frames, doors and other areas where these pests may light or congregate in a similar manner. Allow spray to dry before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Not for use on fire ants. Spray ant trails, ant hills, ant mounds and other areas of entry and infestation. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CONTROL OF ORNAMENTAL GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese beetles hit by spray, as well as whiteflies, aphids, army worms, lace bugs, mealy bugs, exposed thrips, pavement ants, and leafminers.

HOUSE PLANTS: To control Aphids, Japanese beetles, lace bugs, leafminers, mealy bugs, thrips and whiteflies on house plants. Prior to spraying, remove plants from living and eating areas. Put in an area not likely to come in contact with pets, children or food. Plants can be returned to original location when leaves dry. Avoid spraying surrounding areas:

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small ornamental gardens and for spot treatments to prevent insects from spreading into large garden areas.

For **outdoor** use on ornamental plants including **African violet**, barberry, begonia, bromeliad, chrysanthemum, daylily, dianthus, English daisy, **fern**, gardenia, **geranium**, holly, hibiscus, impatiens, ivy, juniper, lantana, marigold, nandina, pansy, photinia, **poinsettia**, poppy, rose and salvia.

When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Spray insects directly whenever possible. **DO** NOT apply to vegetable plants or other plants used for food.
